Our tester Amanda, 25, says: 'My first impressions were it looked classy, though hardcore. But it's flexible and soft, and good if you don't usually focus on your G-spot or aren't sure how to stimulate that area. I used it lying down: the angle put pressure in the right place inside, and the outer bit stimulated me so there was a slow, intense build-up to powerful orgasms.'
